GOVERNMENTAL AFFAIRS DIVISION

___ **Legislative Committee:** Meets regularly during state Legislative Session to review bills affecting business and industry and recommends positions of support or opposition when appropriate. Plans and hosts meeting with elected officials on state and federal levels to discuss legislative priorities. Helps to plan and host Central Louisiana Day at the Legislature.

___ **Infrastructure Committee:** Meets regularly throughout the year to discuss infrastructure needs and develops an annual list of priorities to support economic growth in the region. Assists in communicating infrastructure priorities to local, state, and federal officials.

EDUCATION/WORKFORCE DIVISION

___ **Workforce Development Committee:** Helps link business and industry to secondary and post-secondary education. Works with partner organizations to increase number of Chamber member businesses using WorkKeys system in hiring new employees. Conducts surveys to assess the technical and certificate program needs of area businesses. Reports information gathered to secondary and post-secondary institutions.

MILITARY AFFAIRS DIVISION

___ **Military Affairs Committee:** Maintains relationships and supports Louisiana's military installations, soldiers and families through a variety of initiatives and events. Supports JRTC/Fort Polk, Camp Beauregard and National Guard, V.A. Medical Center, Coast Guard Station at Colfax and USS ALEXANDRIA. (Additional fee to participate - \$150)
